Young Carers New project

Magical Story making Adventure with Grimm & Co

Thanks to funding from *Rotherham Children's Capital of Culture*, we were thrilled to support a group of young carers aged 8–11 in taking part in a magical story making experience at **Grimm & Co's Emporium of Stories**.

From the moment they stepped into the mythical building, the young people were immersed in imagination and creativity. They toured the magical emporium, explored the enchanted library, and stepped *through the wardrobe* to begin a collaborative storytelling adventure.

The workshop began with an imaginative warm-up in the **Imagination Gym**, getting everyone (even the adults!) ready to create. Guided by our magical hosts, Graham and Grizelda Grimm, the group invented characters, designed settings, and shaped the beginning and middle of a story — all while receiving live feedback (and mischief) from the unseen Grimms themselves! To bring their ideas to life, a live illustrator drew each of the children's unique characters onto the story page. The session culminated with each young person writing their own individual story ending, which will be published in a beautifully bound book for them to keep.

Of course, no visit to Grimm & Co is complete without a ride down the **beanstalk slide** and a delicious lunch to round off the day.

As an added bonus, all young people received a **hygiene pack** and a **back-to-school pack**, supporting them not just creatively, but practically too.

It was a day full of imagination, laughter, and storytelling magic — and we are so proud of the young carers for their creativity, enthusiasm, and teamwork throughout the experience.
